## Snapshot: A man \_\_\_\_\_before God

## Snapshot: A man dependent on \_\_\_\_

Main Point 4- A man dependent on Grace

[And it is perfectly proper for God to do this for us because Christ died to wash away our sins.] If we claim we have not sinned, we are lying and calling God a liar, for he says we have sinned.
